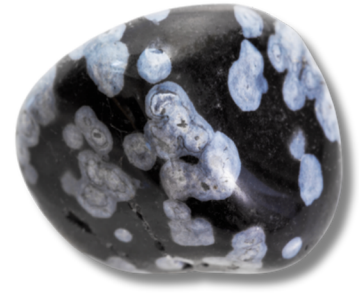


Snowflake Obsidian
